



## OVERVIEW OF THE DESIGNATED SCHOLARSHIPS AT PCT

### ***1. Definition of Designated Scholarship***

Any person who donates funds to PCT can designate the donation for a specified program (Educational Scholarship Program, Community Development Program) and/or for a particular student(s) from a village/ school/ college of his/her choice. Once the student has been awarded PCT scholarship after going through the selection process, the scholarship amount along with a certificate, will be given to him/her **in the name of the donor or his/her business or in honor or memory of a loved one (grand parent, parent, spouse, child etc.)** as requested by the donor. In case the donor can not choose any particular student/school/college/village, we will apply the donation to fund the scholars we select in our regular selection process. A signed copy of the certificate along with the scholar details will be sent to the donor.

### ***2. Selection Process for recipients of designated scholarship***

The selection process for determining the recipients of designated scholarships is no different from the process that we follow for regular students ([www.padalacharitabletrust.org](http://www.padalacharitabletrust.org)). The only difference being the donor may designate a specific village/school/college from which we will have to pick up the best match per PCT's norms (meritorious and poor). In case the donor designates a specific student, we may relax PCT's norms a little bit if needed, in terms of the academic excellence. Our primary goal is to **connect a generous donor to a bright and needy student.**

### ***3. Minimum amount for designated scholarship***

As much as possible (not mandatory), the donor is advised to fund the entire course of the student he/she is designating for. The donation amount must be sufficient enough to cover the tuition fee, books and uniform (if applicable & needed). For ex. if the student is admitted into a 3-yr Polytechnic Course, the amount needed will be around Rs. 4000/- per year. In this case, the donor is requested to fund all 3 yrs of the course (3 X 4000 = Rs. 12000/-) by donating Rs. 4000/- per year. These are the amounts for some of the other courses that PCT offers scholarship for:

Intermediate- 2 X Rs. 2000/- = Rs. 4,000/-	B.A/B.Sc/B.Com - 3 X Rs. 3000/- = Rs. 9,000/-
B.E/B.Tech - 4 X Rs. 10000/- = Rs. 40,000/-	M.A/M.Sc/M/Com - 2 X Rs. 5000/- = Rs. 10,000/-
B.Ed - Rs. 6,000/-	MBBS - 4 X Rs 15000/- = Rs. 60,000/-

### ***4. Keeping the donors informed***

PCT keeps the donors informed of the details of students who are being benefited by their funding each year. These details include the amount given to the student, his/her current contact details and academic progress.

### ***5. To get started***

All you need to do is send a letter/email to PCT with your first donation cheque. In your letter/email, please mention your complete address and also the details of whom you are designating etc. Your **SMALL** contribution makes a **BIG** difference in someone's life by offering life time gift of Education.
